COVID-19 Exposure Guidelines and Screening

Obstetrics & Gynecology Associates is dedicated to protecting our patients, employees, physicians and community during the Covid-19 pandemic. We screen all individuals requesting access to our facility. By answering these questions, you are attesting that you are healthy and have no known exposures to Covid-19.

Face Masks are required during your visit to our office and only the patient is allowed in the office for the appointment, no children, infants or guests. Please call our office @ 972-420-1470 with questions.

Answering **YES** any of the questions below may prevent an individual from being allowed access to the office. If you answer **YES** please contact the office prior to your appointment to discuss your answers to the screening questions or to reschedule your appointment.

1. ***Have you tested positive for Covid-19?***
 - a. Please reschedule your appointment **IF** you **DO NOT** meet the following criteria: **It has been at least 14 days since testing positive for Covid-19, symptoms are significantly improving AND you are fever free without Tylenol or Ibuprofen for 72 hours. Please bring a copy of your POSITIVE test result to your appointment.**
2. ***Have you been exposed to Covid-19 AND asymptomatic?***
 - a. Reschedule your appointment if it has not been at least 14 days since exposure **AND** you are symptom/fever free. If symptoms appear within the 14 -day period contact your primary care physician.
3. ***Have you been exposed to Covid-19 AND experiencing symptoms?***
 - a. Reschedule your appointment and contact your primary care physician.
4. ***Do you have a Covid-19 test pending?***
 - a. Reschedule your appointment.
5. ***Do you have a cough, trouble breathing or sore throat?***
 - a. Reschedule your appointment and contact your primary care physician.
6. ***Do you have a headache, muscle pain, loss of taste or smell and/or diarrhea?***
 - a. Reschedule your appointment and contact your primary care physician.
7. ***Are you feeling feverish or had a fever (chills, body aches, headache)?***
 - a. Reschedule your appointment and contact your primary care physician.
8. ***Have you been or are you in contact with a person who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or is under investigation for COVID- 19?***
 - a. Reschedule your appointment if it has not been at least 14 days since exposure **AND** you are symptom/fever free. If symptoms appear within the 14 day period contact your primary care physician.
9. ***Have you engaged in non-essential travel in the last two weeks?***
 - a. Reschedule your appointment if you have traveled within last 14 days.
